Grades One through Eight Information Sheet

Our school opens at 8:20 AM. The day begins at 8:35 AM and ends at 3:15 PM. The day ends at approximately 11:30 AM on early dismissal days.

Classes in grades one through three are self-contained. In grades four, five and six the students participate in classes taught by several homeroom teachers. The seventh and eighth grade students experience a departmental environment, participating in classes taught by the homeroom teachers in the unit. All students in grades one through eight also attend weekly classes in art, computer, library, music and physical education. Spanish is taught once a week in grades one through four and two times per week in grades five through eight. The Archdiocesan Honors Math Program is offered to students who meet the school's qualifications in grades four through eight.

Special attention is given to the current academic performance, behavior and social skills of students applying for grades one through eight. Complete school records must accompany these registrations.

Each family whose child has been accepted will receive the traditional August mailing which will contain pertinent information for the coming school year.
