Our Lady of Mount Carmel School is partnering with the Doylestown Bookshop to get our students reading this summer! In order to participate in the OLMC School Summer Reading Passport Program, please refer to the directions outlined below.


Students must read 5 books total before the start of the 2025-2026 school year. Two of the books must be from the attached lists, which are organized by grade-level. Students may choose any books they like for the remaining three.

Students will read these books over the summer, and have a parent/guardian sign or initial to verify that they have read that book. Students in grades Kindergarten through 4th grade should list the title and author of each book and write a full sentence describing their favorite part of each book. Students in grades 5th through 8th should list the title, author, main characters, the setting, and the plot (in brief) of each book, as well as a sentence telling about their favorite part of each book. Templates for this have been provided.

Finally, students should take their completed Summer Reading Passport to the Doylestown Bookshop in order to have it stamped. At that time, the Doylestown Bookshop will issue a coupon for 20% off one book. Students should also submit their Summer Reading Passport to their homeroom teacher on the first day of the new school year – and students will also receive a prize from our librarian at that time!
